2004 ANNUAL BANQUET

The Oo Syak Gee Lu Society Annual Banquet will be on Saturday, August 14, 2004, and will be held at the Hee Hing Restaurant at 449 Kapahulu Ave. Again, our society will be supplementing the cost of the banquet. For a member

to purchase a table, the cost is \$150.00, if paid before August 1, 2004. After the August 1, 2004 deadline, the cost is \$300.00 per table. This is the un-supplemented price of a table. In case a whole table cannot be purchased the cost is \$15.00 per member and \$30.00 for non-member guests. We strongly encourage all members to purchase whole tables. The price is right, and it creates less confusion for the banquet committee. Unfortunately, there is a table limit of 34. Reservations and payment will be on a "first come, first served" basis. Once the 34 tables are reserved, no further reservations will be taken.

Goals:

To encourage, motivate, and assist a member student in his/her pursuit for higher education and provide some financial support.

Application Deadline:

Applications must be postmarked no later than Saturday, June 5, 2004. An awards presentation will be held during the Oo Syak Gee Lu's annual banquet in August.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applicants must be members of the Oo Syak Gee Lu Society.
2. Eligible students must be pursuing a higher education: two-year or four-year accredited college; trade school, technical school or graduate school.
3. Awarding of the scholarship will be based on scholastic achievement, extra-curricular activities, leadership, and community involvement.

Scholarship Guidelines:

1. Scholarship money will be given directly to the student to be used for tuition and/or books. (We will inquire as to your schooling, either by mail or email. Preferably by email.)
 2. Enrolled student must be taking a minimum of 12 credits hours of instruction or be a full-time student to receive any funds.
 3. Scholarship is non-transferable.
 4. Scholarship is awarded for one year. Must re-apply annually.
- (The terms and rules of this scholarship program may change or alter without notice.)

Amount of Scholarship:

Four scholarships will be awarded, each in the amount of \$1000.00
