I have a Petition and affidavit of Chang Yick Leong is a Naturalized American Citizen and stating he has 2 sons in Honolulu and 4 sons & 1 daughter & wife Ma Shee residing in China. (petition to bring rest of children & wife to Hawaii) Witnesses to this document are Chun Ming and Hong Quon.... (resided in the Hawaiian Island for 32 and 40 years)...dated May 17, 1911.

TWENTY FOURTH GENERATION: Sum Kung aka Kum Wo, born June 9, 1829, died Dec 21, 1904, married Leong Shee. Sons; Dock and Wong. TWENTY FIFTH GENERATION: Dock Kung aka Yick Sung and Yick Leong Chan, (The Hawaiian Kingdom Record of Naturalization, dated September 29th, 1890), first child to be US Citizen born Sept. 28, 1859, died Dec. 10, 1931. Married Ma Shee....6 sons 1 daughter.... (names when they were single I am not listing them)

My father (Sing Leong 26th generation of Si Shan Chang Family Tree) is the third son of Yick Leong Chang. There are nine children 7 girls and 2 boys. I am the 8th child and 6th daughter. I went out to San Francisco yesterday to check with my 2nd (Beverly Chew) & 3rd (Kwai Owyang) sisters to collect some of their documents. Talked to my brother Vernon (Mun Do) lives in SF and goes back and forth to Hawaii). According to Vernon he is a lifetime member and also other brother Edmund (Mun Jung). Our father gave them lifetime memberships...unfortunately, they are not active members. I noticed faces of the members in photo that needed names, (have to enlarge print copy and check with cousin), seated left Wah Chock the names of others....my father is seated at right corner.

I have to check with my cousin Wah Chock (3rd son of, Sing Cheong, and Chinese secretary in the Oo Syak Kee Lu Society) am not sure if he is still the secretary. I remember my father wanting my cousins to be active in the Society.

My memory is vague I kinda remember my dad (Sing Leong) at one time being the president and treasurer of the Society. Brother Vernon says he remembers driving father to Kukui Street to collect the rent. Vernon's wife (Alice Chun) speaks the Sam Heong dialic.

Alice was not home when I talked to Vernon...I want to email the history (you wrote re Oo Syak Kee Lu)...need to get more information from my oldest sister Edith Dung (age in eighties) lives in Hawaii. Unfortunately some of my older siblings do not email.
